We are a private, non-profit organization that promotes the appreciation and execution of the visual, literary, and performing arts through a wide variety of classes and activities for all age groups. Our gallery provides exhibit space for regional artists, local community groups and school children. Throughout the year we also host recitals, concerts, theatrical productions, and other events.
